

Appropriate Dress for Yugo Mission Trip

Volunteers should dress comfortably and functionally, but they should also be considerate of the conservative culture we are serving.

The Yugo staff recommends shirts with sleeves and pants/jeans, capris, and long skirts (at least knee length, but full length is preferred).

Only knee-length shorts may be worn by both men and women.

For modesty and safety, please follow these rules:

1. No tank shirts at ANY house-building sites or outreach centers.
2. Women must not wear leggings or yoga pants (young girls may wear leggings with a long t-shirt).
3. Shorts are not allowed at the house-build sites. For safety reasons, volunteers must wear long pants at all house-build sites.
4. *Short* shorts are not allowed. Both guys and gals' shorts must be knee-length.
5. Open-toed shoes cannot be worn at any of the house-building sites.

Anyone who is not dressed appropriately will be asked to change.
